



## Memorandum of Understanding Between

Russian-Tajik Slavonic University

Pai Chai University

And

The Republic of Tajikistan

The Republic of Korea

Russian-Tajik Slavonic University in The Republic of Tajikistan and Pai Chai University in The Republic of Korea hereby enter into this General Agreement to foster international cooperation in education and research.

- 1. Both parties agree to encourage the following exchange activities based on their respective academic and educational needs:
  - a. Exchange of faculties, scholars and students.
  - b. Exchange of research educational materials and information.
  - c. Organization of joint conferences and research programs.
  - d. Other exchanges as may be agreed to by both parties.
- 2. The implementation of each exchange based on this agreement will follow guidelines established by each party and shall be mutually acceptable to both parties. Efforts will be made by both parties to find financial resources for carrying out the activities listed above.
- 3. Nothing shall diminish the full autonomy of either institution nor will any constraints be imposed by either upon the other in carrying out the agreement.
- 4. This agreement shall be in force for a period of 5 years (automatically be renewed) from the date of the last signing, and is subject to revision or modification by mutual agreement. It is also understood that this agreement may serve as the basis for

specific agreements to be developed at a later date. It is further understood that either institution may terminate the agreement at any time, although such action will only be taken after mutual consultation in order to avoid any possible inconvenience to either party.

5. This agreement must be executed in English, and is effective when the parties named below have affixed their signatures to the agreement.
